



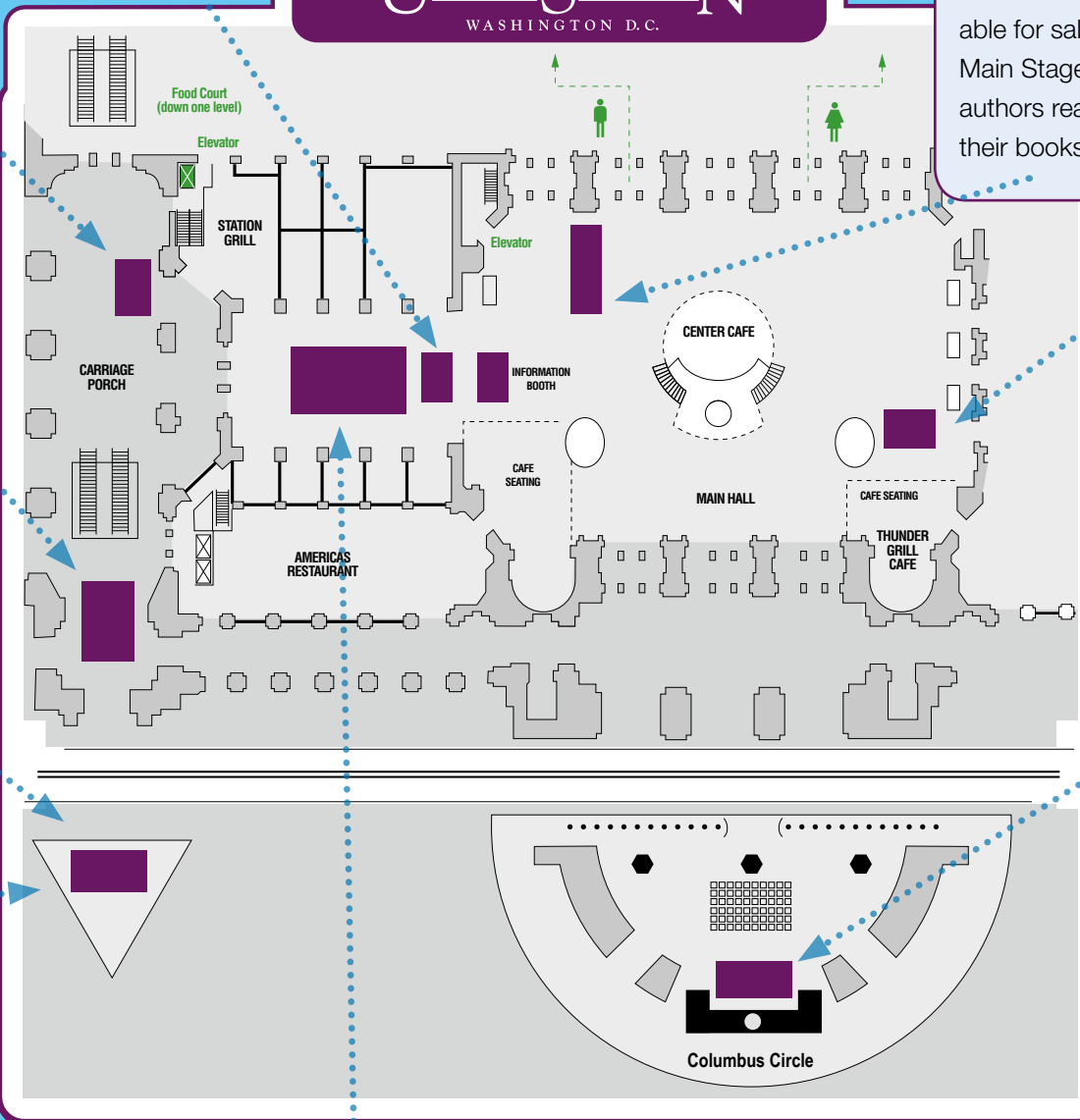
Art Stop • Beading
